AMADEUS

10th Online International Piano Accompanists Competition

(Ukraine, Kharkiv)

March 3-6, 2021

The competition is open for accompanist pianists of 4 age categories:

• Category A – up to 10 y.o., one round;

• **Category B** – 11-14 y.o., one round;

• Category C – 15-18 y.o., two rounds;

• Category D – 19-25 y.o., two rounds.

The age of participants is taken into account as of Jan 1, 2021.

The winners of previous competitions who received Grand Prix and First Degree Diplomas are allowed to participate in the competition, except for the age category in which they won.

Auditions for **Category A** participants are held in one round.

Two different pieces are performed.

The duration of the performance is up to 8 minutes.

Auditions for Category B participants are held in one round.

The following pieces are performed:

1) an instrumental piece by W. A. Mozart or a vocal piece by W. A. Mozart;

2) a piece by a composer from the participant's country;

3) a piece of the participant's choice;

The performance must take up to 10 minutes.

Auditions for **Category C** participants are held in two rounds.

Round I:

1) A sonata by W. A. Mozart or an aria from an opera, cantata, or oratorio by W. A. Mozart;

2) a piece by a composer from the participant's country;

Round II:

1) An instrumental or a vocal piece by a Romantic composer;

2) A piece of the participant's choice.

The performance in each round must take up to 15 minutes

The auditions for **Category D** participants are held in two rounds: Round I:

1) The first part, or the second and third parts of a concerto by W. A. Mozart, or an aria (a scene) from an opera, oratorio, cantata, etc. of increased complexity;

2) A piece of the participant's choice.

Round II:

1) A vocal or instrumental cycle;

2) A piece by a composer from the participant's country; The performance in each round must take up to 25 minutes.

Applications for the competition are to be submitted by January **21**, **2021** to W. A. Mozart Children's Music School No. 15 in digital format only (.doc, .docx files) to the following email addresses: dmsh15@ymail.com or oatarasowa@gmail.com.

Video recordings of the performances for the competition (both rounds for participants of categories C and D) are to be sent from February 10 to February 25, 2021 as a link to a *YouTube video with open access* to the following email addresses: <u>dmsh15@ymail.com</u> or <u>oatarasowa@gmail.com</u>.

The application should be accompanied by:

1) a copy of the birth certificate or a photocopy of pages 1 and 2 of the participant's, illustrator's, or teacher's passport;

2) a copy of the participant's, illustrator's, or teacher's taxpayer identification number;

3) a high-quality digital portrait photo of the participant (at least 600X800 pixels, JPG format);

4) a participant's creative CV.

8. Technical requirements for video recording:

1) the video must be recorded without cuts, in a single wide shot; the hands of a performer, the instrument and the performer him- or herself must be clearly seen;

2) all performances of a single round are recorded in a single file without editing;

3) an amateur recording format is allowed if all other conditions of the contest are met. If the video does not meet the technical requirements of the competition, the submitted application will not be considered.

Prizes and Awards

1. All participants of the competition, teachers, illustrators, employees of the organizing school, and jury members are awarded souvenirs, diplomas, and reading materials.

2. In each age category of the contest, according to the decision of the jury, the titles of Laureate of I, II, or III degree and of a diploma winner are awarded. For outstanding artistic achievements, participants can be awarded the Grand Prix (one for all age categories). Laureates and diploma holders of the contest, best illustrators, and teachers are awarded diplomas of laureates (diploma winners), valuable gifts, souvenirs, and other prizes.

Special prizes can also be awarded.

3. The jury has the right to change the number of prize-winners in each category, depending on the skill level of the participants. In a situation where no worthy

candidates for prizes can be determined, these places are not allotted. The head of the jury has one additional vote in resolving controversial issues.

Financial Conditions of the Competition

1. The competition is financed from the allocations provided for in the city budget of Kharkiv for the specified purpose, according to the calendar plans of the Department of Culture of Kharkiv City Council (its structural subdivision or institution) established for the respective year, and other sources which are not prohibited by the current legislation of Ukraine.

2. Diplomas and prizes are sent at the expense of the participants by post service.
